Mount Snow Academy seeks professional instructors/tutors for middle and high school level Spanish. This is an hourly position, based upon enrollment, and can be performed remotely via Zoom or Google Meet, however, we do plan on welcoming teachers to join us on campus this season. We seek candidates who have recent experience teaching and/or tutoring Spanish from beginner to advanced levels and who are passionate about working with student-athletes.

Mount Snow Academy is a winter sports academy in southern Vermont. All of our classes are taught one-on-one and we maintain a high academic standard while fostering each student's unique athletic calling. Our students compete in alpine racing, freeskiiing, and snowboarding at the local, state, regional, and national levels, and developments in the facility have improved our program and spurred recent growth.

Our academic program runs from November 2 - April 9th; not all students enrolled in Spanish classes will be with us for that entire period, as some join us for just 6 weeks or a few months. Our daily academic schedule will be contingent upon training space at our training venue(s). Traditionally, classes have been held between 8 am and 5 pm on Mondays through Thursdays (no classes Fridays). There is some flexibility within this for creating individual teaching schedules. Orientation and training will take place remotely during October.
